Introduction

JMyLife was originally conceived as a clone of the popular site FMyLife. Since its inception, however, JMyLife has started to take on a life of its own as a microblogging tool for Joomla!®

The basic premise of JMyLife is to allow users, and even guests, to submit stories to your site, and to allow other users to interact with the story by voting it up or down, adding comments, and sharing with their friends. JMyLife can be used not only as a microblogging tool, but also as a guestbook or an advice component.

JMyLife Pro integrates with both JomSocial and Community Builder, the most popular community extensions for Joomla!® JMyLife will automatically install plugins to integrate with your user profiles with profile menus and lists of the users' own stories and their favorites! It also links stories to the authors by showing avatars!

Another community advantage of JMyLife Pro is the ability to allow your users to moderate stories for you, by presenting them with unpublished stories which can be voted upon, and if desired automatically published once enough individual users agree vote in favor of its publication.

For those that require more power in managing their comments, JMyLife Pro supports the integration of the following 3rd party comment engines:

- Disqus
- JomComment
- !JoomlaComment
- Jcomments

Also, JMyLife Pro offers extra security on the story submission form by supporting multiple captcha engines:

- reCAPTCHA
- captchas.net
- Bigo Captcha

Pro also includes over a half dozen helper extensions, like a submission module, a category menu, modules to display comments and stories, and a search plugin. These extensions enhance the user experience by allowing more information and interaction with the component.

Installation

JMyLife takes a simple approach to installation and upgrade – everything is handled by a single package! Just install the downloaded .zip file as you would any other component, even when upgrading!

All Pro helper extensions will be installed with JmyLife. Any 3rd party integrations will also be installed automatically!

Once JMyLife is installed, it needs to have a menu item set up for at least the default List view. This can be done in the core Joomla!® “Menus” section.

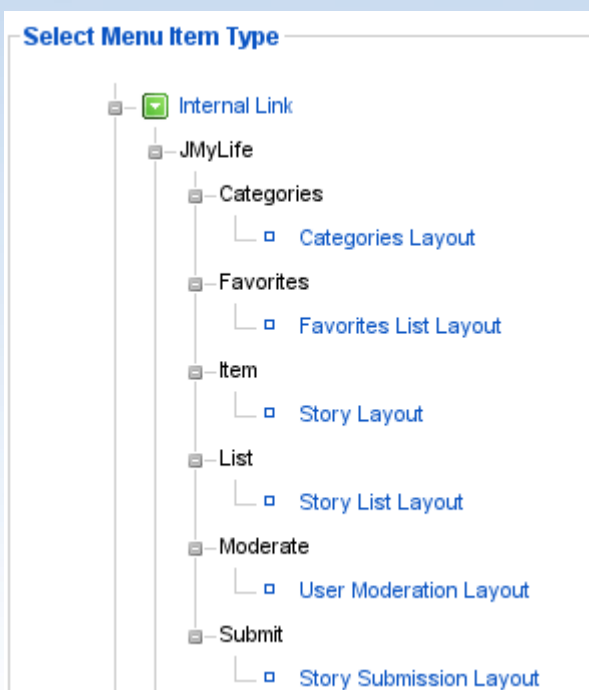

Next Steps

Once JMyLife has been installed, the next step you'll want to take is to create a menu item. This is done using Joomla!®'s core Menus component.



JMyLife offers six different views for the frontend user:

Categories – display a static list of the available, with descriptions of each.

*Favorites** - displays a list of a user's favorite stories. This view is best used as a Registered menu item, incorporated into your User menu.

Item – display a single story, and can also double as a Random story.

List – the most important view of JMyLife, the list view displays a list of stories based on the parameters given for this view:

*Moderate** - this view allows users to vote on unpublished stories. This allows your community to “self moderate.”

Submit – a static view to allow users to submit stories. It is recommended to create a Menu Item of this type to be assigned to the Submission Module's Javascript toggle.

* these views are only available in JMyLife Pro

Configuration

JMyLife has its configuration split into multiple tabs for easier navigation. Each option has a description of it's function, so consult the description for each individual option.

It is possible to safely browse all tabs before committing any changes, and this view enables the core keepalive behavior, so your session will not end while editing the configuration.

Comments Tab

- **Allow Comments** - Should comments be allowed? Setting to "no" will disable comments site-wide!
- **Show Comment Counts** - If this is disabled, stories will not display comment counts and will instead display story links as #id, as if the story's comments were disabled.
- **Show Comment Balloon** - If enabled, when a user mouses over the 'read comments' link, a balloon will appear showing the latest comments for that story.
- **Comment Balloon Count** - How many comments maximum should be shown in the Comment Balloon.
- **Comment Balloon Width** - Set the width, in pixels, of the comment balloon.
- **Comment Balloon Preview Length** - Set a limit on the length of the comments shown in the Comment Balloon.
- **Comment Engine** - Comment engine to use. Only detected and supported options are shown. JMyLife currently supports JomComment, JComments, ! JoomlaComment and Disqus. PLEASE NOTE any settings regarding email notifications for comments in the Email tab will be ignored when using 3rd party comment solutions.

Comments Tab, continued

■ Core

- **Comment Pagination** - When enabled, comments will be paginated. When disabled, all comments for a single story will be shown.
- **Autopublish Comments** - Should comments be published automatically?
- **Warning Level** - How many warnings should a comment get before being hidden?
- **Show username instead of Real Name on comments** - Show commenter's username instead of real name?

■ Disqus

- **Disqus Shortname** - The shortname associated with your Disqus account. This is required for the correct operation of Disqus.
- **Disqus API Key** - This key is used to retrieve certain information from your Disqus account. To get your API key, first log in to Disqus then visit http://disqus.com/api/get_my_key/ to retrieve it.
- **Disqus Forum Key** - This key is used to retrieve certain information from your Disqus account.
- **Disqus Developer Mode** - This option enables developer mode, which allows testing to be done on local, protected, or otherwise inaccessible servers.

■ JomComment

- **Hide Disabled JomComment** - When this setting is disabled, stories whose comments have been disabled will still show JomComment in a disabled state.
- **Use JomComment Content Tools** - Enable this to use the JomComment tools instead of the JMyLife core item footer.
- **Use JomComment Template Cache** - Use JomComment template cache.

Community Tab

- **Social Engine** - Choose the social engine to be used with JMyLife. Only detected engines will be displayed. Supported engines include JomSocial and Community Builder.
- **Common**
 - **Show Story Avatar** - Show author's avatar in story?
 - **Link Story Avatar** - Link story avatar to user's profile.
 - **Link Story Author** - Link story author name to profile.
 - **Show Comment Avatar** - Show user avatar in comments.
 - **Link Comment Avatar** - Comment avatar is linked to the user's profile.
 - **Link Comment Author** - Link user name to profile in comments.
 - **Disable Avatar Alt Tags** - Normally, avatars will have the username as the alt tag. This will disable this behavior and instead leave an empty alt tag.

Community Tab, continued

- **Community Builder**

- **Extra Community Builder Fields** - Custom Community Builder fields to be added to the story footer. The selected fields will be shown in the same order given in the Community Builder Field Management screen. PLEASE NOTE your database user MUST have permissions to create views in order for this to function properly!

- **JomSocial**

- **Story Publication Updates Activities** - If enabled, when a story is published it updates the JomSocial activity stream.
- **Guest Story Publication Updates Activities** - If enabled, guest stories will appear in the JomSocial activity stream.
- **Comment Publication Updates Activities** - If enabled, published comments will appear in the JomSocial activity stream.
- **Adding Favorites Updates Activities** - If enabled, whenever a user adds a new favorite story it will appear in the JomSocial activity stream.

Custom CSS Tab

- **Use Custom CSS?** - Custom CSS will only be used if explicitly enabled.
- **Custom CSS** - Select your custom css here. Any files that appear disabled exist but are unwritable. These files are located in `components/com_jmylife/assets/css/custom/`

The Custom CSS tab contains a simple demo of a story, and a textarea for editing your custom CSS. Please note that the preview does not include every element available, nor does it import the CSS from any template, and therefore may not be an accurate representation of how JMyLife will appear on your site. It is recommended to use development tools such as Firebug for determining the classes and ids applied to each element.





















Email Configuration Tab

- **Enable Notification Email** - Should emails be sent when an event occurs?
- **Email To** - Who should receive event emails?
- **Capture Guest Email** - If this option is enabled, the submission form will have a field to allow guests to leave their email in order to allow guests to receive notifications.
- **Notify on New Stories** - Should the configured address be notified when someone submits a new story?
- **Notify Authors on Story Publication** - If this is set, authors will be sent email notifications when their stories are published. If "Capture Guest Email" is disabled while this is enabled, only registered users will be notified. If this is disabled and "Capture Guest Email" is enabled, guest author emails will be captured but no notifications will be sent.
- **Notify on New Comments** - Should the configured address be notified when someone submits a new comment?
- **Notify Author on New Comments** - Users will be notified when a comment is posted on their story. If "Capture Guest Email" is disabled or the guest did not leave an email, this setting will be ignored.
- **Notify Others on New Comments** - Any user that comments on a story will be notified if a new comment is posted for the same story.
- **Notify on Warning Level** - Should the configured email receive notification when a comment has reached its warning level?
- **Notify on Any Warning** - Notify when any comment receives a warning?
- **Notify on Moderation Limit** - Should the configured email be notified when a story reaches its moderation limit?
- **Allow Guests to Send to Friend** - If enabled, guests will be allowed to send links to their friends via email.

Email Texts Tab

The Email Texts tab contains sliders for each configurable email text. Each email has a subject and a body. Please refer to the Configuration > Email Texts tab for the available replacements for each.

Language Tab

The Language tab allows the admin to change the text of certain elements found throughout JMyLife.

- **Story**

- **Read More Text** - This text will appear on the link that leads to each story.
- **Pre Text** - This text will be shown before every story.
- **Post Text** - This text will be shown after every story.
- **Default Admin Response** - If text is entered here, each story will show this as the default admin response. This setting affects all stories retroactively.

- **Voting**

- **Vote Good Text** - What should the "Good" vote text say? This will override the installed language file.
- **Vote Good Response Text** - What should the "Good" vote response text say? This will override the installed language file.
- **Vote Bad Text** - What should the "Bad" vote text say? This will override the installed language file.
- **Vote Bad Response Text** - What should the "Bad" vote response text say? This will override the installed language file.

- **Submissions**

- **Submission Form Pre Text** - This text will be shown before the core submission form.
- **Submission Form Post Text** - This text will be shown after the core submission form.
- **Submission Form Button Text** - This text will be displayed on the story submit button.

- **Moderate**

- **Moderate View Yes Button** - Text to be displayed on the "Yes" button in Moderation view.
- **Moderate View No Button** - Text to be displayed on the "No" button in Moderation view.
- **Moderate View How-To Link Text** - Text to be displayed on the "How To" link in Moderation view.
- **Moderate View How-To Text** - Text to be displayed on the "How To" drop down in Moderation view.

- **Footer Toggle** - Use Mootools to toggle item footer
- **ShareThis Link** - Enable ShareThis Link? If enabled, the options to show a "Share on Facebook", "Share on Twitter", and "Send to Friend" will be ignored and the links will not be shown. In order for this link to be shown, you MUST sign up for an account at ShareThis and ensure that your site is in compliance with the Terms and Conditions of ShareThis.
- **ShareThis Link Code** - In order for the ShareThis link to function properly, you must first create a ShareThis button. At the end of the creation process, you will be given a snippet of code that looks like this: `<script type="text/javascript" src="http://w.sharethis.com/button/sharethis.js#publisher=XXXXXXXX-XXXX-XXXX-XXXX-XXXXXXXXXXXX&type=website"></script>` Please copy ONLY the contents of the script tag's "src" attribute (`http://w.sharethis.com/button/sharethis.js#publisher=XXXXXXXX-XXXX-XXXX-XXXX-XXXXXXXXXXXX&type=website`) to this input, not the entire script.
- **Facebook Link** - Enable link to share on Facebook?
- **Open Facebook in Modal** - Should Facebook be opened in a modal window? Note that by doing so, the cancel button will be useless in the window itself.
- **Twitter Link** - Enable link to share on Twitter?
- **Favorites Link** - Disable this to disable the Add to Favorites link.
- **Send to Friend Link** - Show a link to open a simple inline form that allows a user to send a link to a story to a friend via email.
- **Send to Friend Form Button Text** - This text will display on the Send to Friend form button.
- **Report Link** - Show a link that allows users to report stories for being spam or otherwise abusive. Please note that this link will not show if "Enable Notification Email" is "No" or "Email To" is not set.

- **Powered By Link?** - Show the "Powered By" link on front end?
- **Show Site Description** - When enabled, the Site Description given in the Administration tab will be shown above the main List view when the category is set to "All".
- **Show Category Description** - When enabled, the description given for each category will appear above the stories in List view when viewing a specific category.
- **Story Background** - Background color for story items.
- **Rounded Corners** - Should layout use rounded corners?
- **Rounded Corners in IE** - Load JS library to make rounded corners in IE
- **Rounded Corner Radius** - Radius, in px, of rounded corners.
- **Break Long Words?** - Should long words be broken with null characters?
- **Graphical Voting?** - If enabled, voting links will be shown to the left of the story and have icons, rather than being inline text.
- **Graphical Voting Size** - The size of the graphical voting icons, if graphical voting is enabled.

- **Autopublish Stories** - Should stories be published automatically?

- **Moderation Limit** - How many "Yes" votes should a story receive before either being published or alerting the admin?
- **Publish on Moderation Limit** - Should stories be automatically published when they reach their moderation limit?
- **Moderation Report Link** - Show Report link in Moderation view?

- **Allow Titles** - If set to "yes" stories will allow users to submit titles for stories
- **Require Titles** - If set to "yes" titles will be required for stories
- **Link Titles** - If set to "yes" titles will be linked to story item view
- **Bad Words Filter** - This will filter bad words from the stories. Each filter should appear on its own line in the format "bad word:good word". These filters are case sensitive. Bad words are filtered at the display level only, so the original profanities will still appear in the database.
- **Story List Preview Limit** - Limit stories in List and Favorites views to a number of characters. 0 to disable.

Story Submission Module

The Story Submission module allows a user to post stories from any page on your site. It allows for text to be placed either before or after the form. The module is initially hidden, and can either be toggled by a link present in the module itself, or by hooking to a menu item link (NOTE: this feature ONLY works when your menu module uses a List type menu). There are two layouts available, Horizontal and vertical, and the dimensions used by the submission textarea can also be set.

FAQs

- **I have an older version of JMyLife Installed. How do I upgrade?**

Just install the latest .zip file! The JMyLife installer doubles as an upgrade install, adding the new functionality and fixes to your existing installation! It is even possible to install the latest Pro version over the Free version, so if you have already started configuring your site using JMyLife Free, an upgrade to Pro is just a few clicks away!

- **Why is reCAPTCHA not showing on my submission form?**

reCAPTCHA requires a Public and Private API key to be entered in the JMyLife configuration. Sign up for your keys at <http://recaptcha.net/>

- **Why does my submission form return a blank page?**

Sometimes, templates, modules or plugins can cause incompatibilities with the functions of JMyLife. The issue is generally caused by Javascript errors which halt the execution of the JMyLife scripts.

- **Why is there nothing but links in the Categories View?**

Ensure that your Category View is assigned to a Menu Item.

- **Why is the text not shown in my editor when I edit the site texts or emails?**

You are likely using a WebKit based browser like Safari or Google Chrome. There is a known issue with the most popular editors (TinyMCE, JCE) when they are used in the core sliders. There is a toggle in the Administration tab that will disable editors if this is an issue for you.

- **How do I make Disqus work?**

First, go to <http://disqus.com> and sign up for an account. During the signup process, you will be asked to provide a shortname, which needs to be input into JMyLife's "Disqus Shortname" configuration field. Once your account is set up, while logged in visit http://disqus.com/api/get_my_key/ and copy that key into the "Disqus API Key" configuration field. Once these two fields are correctly configured, the "Disqus Forum Key" configuration field has a link within its description. Clicking this link should retrieve your Forum API Key automatically.



FAQs

- **What happened to my background colors?**

If you find your background colors are “missing” go to Configuration and immediately save. Due to a change in JMyLife 1.0.11, certain configurations may temporarily lose their backgrounds. Simply saving the configuration page once will resolve this.

- **How do I make my Submission Form module slide in and out of view?**

Edit the instance of mod_jmylifesubmit in Extensions > Module Manager and ensure that the “Javascript Toggle” parameter is set to “Yes” and you have selected an item that appears in a non-Legacy *List*-type menu module for the “Toggle Menu Item”.

- **Where are the modules? Where are the plugins?**

Modules and plugins are only available in JMyLife Pro.

- **Can I remove the “Powered By” link?**

This option is available in JMyLife Pro.

- **Where can I download the latest version?**

Log in to your account at <http://jeffchannell.com> and go to Account Maintenance > View Orders. The latest release is available in your order details.

- **I need JMyLife to support feature X. Can you add this for me?**

Feature requests are always taken under advisement, but I cannot guarantee that every requested feature will make it into JMyLife. If you are in need of the immediate inclusion of some feature into JMyLife, I offer customization services. More details can be found at <http://jeffchannell.com/Services/jmylife-customization.html>
