

MSI-vB Engine Guide

I. Prerequisites

- ✓ BBPixel Core Engine 1.x
- ✓ vBulletin 4.0.x
- ✓ PHP 4.1.x or later
- ✓ Mysql 4.1.x or later

II. Clean new installation

A. Copy Files

1. Rename "`\upload\vbbulletin\msicore\config.php-dist`" to "`config.php`"
2. Edit "`config.php`" above and fill in All necessary settings value via comment instructions.
Note: this config.php file is the same with the one of MSI Core Engine, you can take a copy from MSI Core Engine and put it here.
3. Copy all files + folders inside "`\upload\vbbulletin`" to **vBulletin root path**, ex: `yoursite.com/vb`.
This step may be overwritten some vBulletin core files but it is fine.
4. Copy all files + folders inside "`\upload\msi`" to **MSI core root path**, ex: `yoursite.com/msi`.

B. MSI :: plug-in

- Point browser to "`yoursite.com/vb/msicore/install.php`" and do as its instruction.

Note:

- 1.** You **Must Backup your vBulletin + MSI database** first.
- 2.** This installer script can be only run at once. Remember to delete this installer file for your own security.

C. Synchronize Users

- Login to MSI Core Engine -> Synchronize -> Status
- Click Synchronize icon of Core Plug-in first, then to vBulletin Plug-in

Note: If there is duplicate record Error occurred, clicking on Fixes icon of vBulletin Plug-in and try again.

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D. Ajax form customizing

1. Making login/register form

- Login to vBulletin Admin CP -> Style Manager -> Select Current Template Set :: Edit header template

Find and Remove following code:

```
<ul class="nouser">
...
...
</ul>
```

Below the code, there are links for 'Increase Size' and 'Decrease Size'.

Then, replace with new login code:

```

<a href="http://yoursite.com/msi/remote.php?act=login&redirect=http://yoursite.com" onclick="return GB_show('Login System',
this.href, 330, 500, '')"> {vb:rawphrase log_in}</a>
<a href="http://yoursite.com/msi/remote.php?act=reg&redirect=http://yoursite.com" onclick="return GB_show('Register System',
this.href, 430, 500, '')">{vb:rawphrase register}</a>
</div>
```

Note: You must change "yoursite.com/msi" URL to properly URL of your current MSI location.

III. Upgrading

- Do like Section II -> A -> 3 + 4 above

IV. Note

- MSI engine now will control User registration, userCP and User Management. So you will need to take note to use MSI engine instead of the one of vBulletin.
