

MSI-Core Engine Guide

I. Prerequisites

- ✓ PHP 4.1.x or later
- ✓ Mysql 4.1.x or later

II. Clean new installation

A. Copy Files

1. Rename "`\msi\config.php-dist`" to "`config.php`"
2. Edit "`config.php`" above and fill in All necessary settings value via comment instructions.
3. Rename "`\msi\config_recaptcha.php-dist`" to "`config_recaptcha.php`".
4. Go to <http://recaptcha.net/api/getkey> and sign up an account for your site. Then editing `config_recaptcha.php` with properly value got from recaptcha site.

Note: As default, we **Enable** Re-Captcha SSL connection. You can Disable it and use Normal connection by changing setting as following:

`$cSSL = true;`

To

`$cSSL = false;`

5. Copy "`\msi`" folder to any location you want, ex: `yoursite.com/msi`.

B. Database

- Use Hosting Control Panel -> Database manager to create new Database name and Database account.
- Point browser to "`yoursite.com/msi/install.php`" and do as its instruction.

Note: This installer script can be only run at once. Remember to delete this installer file for your own security.

C. Security

- You should Protect MSI folder with HTTP Authenticate method to increase security. This task can be found in any Hosting Control panel called "**Password Protect Directories**" or similar name. Below is some helpful links which can help you find out how to protect a directory by using Hosting Control panel:

- MSI engine now will control User registration, userCP and User Management. So you will need to take note to use MSI engine instead of the one of third party scripts.
